a Mini Toolbar opens, which shows the most-likely
 commands for this element. Where applicable, a drag handle for the first command in the Mini Toolbar also appears (Cancel is visible in the lower-left corner of the viewport).

## - Action

When you click either a button on the Mini Toolbar or the drag handle, the element is selected and the
 related command starts (OK and Cancel are visible in the lower-left corner of the viewport).
